Selected project experience

Evaluation of the Natural Resources Investment Program (Victorian Department of Sustainability and Environment): Aither evaluated the Victorian Natural Resources Investment Program against the Government's guidelines for the review of lapsing programs. This included assessing the appropriateness, effectiveness and efficiency of the program, and governance and funding arrangements.

Independent review of the *Product Stewardship (Oil)* Act 2000 (Department of the Environment): The review assessed the appropriateness, effectiveness and efficiency of the PSO Scheme, and analysed its financial and environmental sustainability using economic modelling techniques. The project included extensive consultation with industry and government, and highlighted critical changes required.

Review of State of the Environment Reporting in Victoria (Office for Commissioner for Environmental Sustainability): Aither was engaged to examine the current state of the environment monitoring and reporting practices, and whether these practices are relevant and effective for optimum prioritisation and decision making by government.

Assessment of opportunities to maximise the value of environmental and NRM services (Melbourne Water Corporation): Aither explored opportunities for services to better contribute to Melbourne Water's strategic goals - including how service offerings could be enhanced, extended or transformed to provide greater value and benefits over different time horizons. A key driver of the review was the need for service offerings to better contribute to urban liveability outcomes.

Benchmarking performance (North Central Catchment Management Authority): Aither assisted North Central in development of an organisation-wide NRM performance standard. The project included the development of an effective standard that can be applied in a range of settings, and performance metrics to track performance over time.
